



In order to re-open living and learning in our campus community while minimizing person-to-person transmission of COVID-19 and protecting those most vulnerable to the disease, OFS has established these behavioral expectations for OFS students, employees and families. We will need the full support of our entire community to keep our campus healthy and safe.

We recognize that these challenging times call for changes in how we conduct our school operations as well as our own lives. Living in a time of COVID-19 necessitates these temporary changes, in order to protect everyone: our students, faculty, staff, and community, to the best of our abilities. We must all agree – and understand that everyone else on campus has agreed – to abide by certain behavioral guidelines so that everyone on campus has a reasonable sense of security. These guidelines may be modified over time as changes warrant.

By joining us this academic year, you agree to abide by the expectations as stated below. We ask parents and families to discuss health and safety regarding both on- and off-campus spaces and personal relationships, and to each do their part in protecting the community.

## **2020-2021 Agreement to Support School Safety & Health**

As members of the Oakwood Friends community and in recognition that this pandemic impacts our friends, our families and our world, we pledge to protect the health and safety of every member of our campus community.

- We will protect ourselves.
- We will protect others.
- We will protect our OFS community.

I understand, as a member of the Oakwood Friends community, that I am an important part of the school and that the community is stronger when we all do our part to keep the OFS campus safe. I understand that the health and safety guidelines below are necessary to protect the health and safety of others in my community and beyond.

- I agree to abide by all federal, state, city, and OFS mandates, policies, protocols, and procedures related to COVID-19.
- I agree to honestly fill out a daily health form, participate in morning temperature screening, monitor my symptoms, be tested as recommended by health professionals, and cooperate in the tracing of my contacts and follow quarantine or isolation orders should I test positive.



- I agree to stay home if I feel sick or if I experience any symptom associated with COVID-19 and to notify the school the reason for my absence.
- I agree to maintain physical distance (6 feet) from others whenever possible.
- I agree to wear a mask when I leave my house/dorm room for the duration of the day.
- I agree to effective hand hygiene: washing my hands frequently for at least 20 seconds (or utilizing hand sanitizer if a sink is not readily available) frequently throughout the day.
- I agree to refrain from organizing, hosting or attending events or other social gatherings off-campus that may cause safety risks to me and other members of the community.
- I agree to avoid unnecessary travel. If anyone in your household has traveled to a COVID-19 “hot spot” designated by the CDC, you are required to notify the School and keep your child home for at least two weeks. This applies to all states listed on the NY quarantine list at any time.
- I agree that if I believe that a member of our immediate family has been exposed to someone infected with COVID-19, I will be expected to keep my student out of school for at least two weeks. In addition, the School may require a two-week quarantine in case of exposure at school.
- I agree to refrain from having guests, including family or day students, in my dorm and to follow the visitation guidelines.

***I understand that violations of this agreement could result in being sent home to continue learning remotely. OFS takes behavior that jeopardizes the health and safety of others in the community seriously and will respond appropriately.***
